

## DONNA ROHAUS IS COMING TO KCTC JULY 14<sup>th</sup> !

Donna Rohaus has been involved in agility since 1998 and has been teaching in southwestern Pennsylvania since 2000. She has trained her own dogs, Border Collies and an All-American, to top levels of different organizations, including AKC, UKI, and USDAA, and has been a finalist many times at national events. She was on the world team with her first Border Collie, Cap. Her students, including KCTC members, have also had great success in agility, some at the national level. She works with all breeds and ages, including young dogs, and enjoys passing on her knowledge and experience.

Donna will be offering the following workshops on July 14th:

9:00 AM – 11:00 AM - **Young dogs, including non-agility dogs!** – Games to keep your dog engaged with you to keep your dog's attention. Bring a hungry dog (don't feed them breakfast), toys, their breakfast if you feed kibble, and lots of small soft treats. No minimum age. Some class experience required, equivalent to Puppy Pre-School, Building Puppy Confidence, or Family Manners 1.

11:15 AM - 1:15 PM - **Intermediate Handling** – Sequences that include front and rear crosses and serpentines.

1:30 PM - 3:30 PM – **Contacts – 2on/2off**. Foundations for 2on/2off end behavior for the contact obstacles (the A-frame, teeter and dogwalk). Teach the end behavior first, the 2on/2off, then the rest is easy!

3:40 – 5:40 PM - **Beginner Handling** - The basics of front and rear crosses, and serpentines. Mastering these skills gives you the foundation for skillful handling.

All sessions will be taught in small groups (5 handler maximum per group). The cost is \$60 for each session, payable to KCTC the day of the sessions.
