
## HAIR OF THE DOG PARTY

## KEYSTONE CANINE TRAINING ELECTIONS

In accordance with the Bylaws of Keystone Canine Training Club, Section 1. Biennial Election. "The biennial election of Officers and Directors shall be held during the May membership meeting in even-numbered years, by secret ballot." I will be serving as Chairman of the Nominating Committee and need your help in preparing a good slate of candidates. In order to be eligible to be nominated for office, an individual must be at least 18 years of age and a member of the club in good standing for a period of at least one year as of the May meeting before she or he can be nominated for a Board of Director position. If you are this person please contact me and I will submit your name to the nominating committee. If you know of a person who fits this criteria and would be a good candidate for a Board position, please contact that person prior to nominating him/her to be sure they are willing to serve if elected. The Board positions and their responsibilities are as follows:

**President** shall preside at all meetings of the Club and the Board and shall have the duties specified by the KCC Constitution and Bylaws.

Vice President shall have the duties and exercise the power of the president in the case of the president's absence or incapacity, etc. The vice president will serve as Co-Chairperson for matches and trials.

#### Total Recall

Training Director shall direct the scheduling of all classes, shall direct curriculum, and shall be available to counsel instructors. The training director (or his/her delegated representative) shall also revise the club's Policies and Procedures as needed, and submit such revisions to the Board for approval by majority vote.

**Treasurer** shall receive and record all receipts and monies due or belonging to the club. He/she shall deposit same in a bank satisfactory to and in the name of the club. His/her books shall at all times be open to the inspection of the Board and, at the discretion of the Board, open for any audit. He/she shall report to the Board at every meeting the condition of the club's finances and a report of all monies received and expended during the previous month. All checks, notes, vouchers, drafts, acceptances and other orders for the payment of monies by the club shall be signed by the treasurer or other Board member(s) as approved by the club's financial institution.

## **Corresponding**

### Secretary/Membership Chairperson's

duties are to serve as a Board member, to prepare and mail all club materials (including notification of the time and place of special membership and special Board meetings), to lend as much assistance as possible to committee chairpersons with mailings that pertain to the club's business, to maintain all correspondence of the club, and to execute such other duties as are prescribed by the KCC Constitution and Bylaws.

Recording Secretary will serve as a Board member, record the minutes and transactions of the Board and Membership meetings, furnish a copy of the meeting minutes to the newsletter editor, furnish the president with a copy of the minutes prior to the next meeting, and carry out such other duties as are prescribed by the KCC Constitution and Bylaws.

Office Manager shall maintain class schedules, coordinate with website/call back person, respond to e-mails to the website "Contact Us" link, maintain class applications and participant listings, maintain building supplies, maintain the monthly schedule display at the building, deliver all needed information to the treasurer, coordinate with the cleaning person, coordinate with the training director and maintain a list of keys to the building.

Other Board Members may be assigned to special tasks such as webmaster, community outreach, public relations, etc. on an as-needed basis.
