Obedience Run-Thrus will be held on Saturday, November 21 and Sunday, December 20 from 11:00 to 12:00.

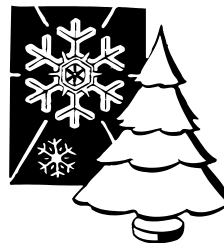
Rally Run-Thrus will be held Sunday, November 15 and December 20 from 9:00 to 11:00 am.
