On Sunday, Sept 5, at the same trials, Sawyer got his first Open Fast leg with a first place and also qualified in Standard Excellent for his 5th leg towards his master's agility title. Pebbles had a successful return to CPE agility in August. In two weekends she earned 12 Qs and completed two Level 1 titles and one Level 2 title!
