

NEW CLASS – DOG OBEDIENCE 101.5

This class is for dogs who have previously taken Basic or Puppy Obedience. The first classroom session will enable the handlers to present what their weakest areas are, and that becomes the main thrust for the subsequent weeks. In addition to solving individual problems, some of the aspects from Basic II will be taught so that when handlers take the class, Basic II, it will not all be new. This is an ideal class for someone who has just recently finished the Basic class, as it provides a strengthening and review. It also is for someone who is further along and finds that they do not get the kind of response to basic commands that they expect; for example, when working in Rally or Agility.
