DECEMBER SHORT SESSION

AGILITY LESSONS

Donna Rohaus will be coming to KCTC on Sunday, December 20, for private or semi-private agility lessons. Donna will train your dog at any level (puppy to beginner to advanced competition), and on any particular thing you want to work on (handling skills, contacts, weaves, etc.). She also won "High-In-Trial Therapy Dog" for being the Therapy Dog in the competition with the most points, and the "Mystery Pair" competition where you are secretly teamed up with another dog in your competition height and

the winners are the two dogs with the highest score for the day. She was also next to the oldest dog in the competition. For everyone who knows Sadie and her infamous "start-line stay", we have to note that on Call, Direct and Send, where the challenge was for dogs not to cross the start line before the handlers were within the containment area which was three jumps away, Sadie
