A Message from the President

I hope everyone had a Happy Halloween, and that it was not too scary for your dogs.

We are having some non-spooky upcoming events:

This is mainly to increase friction, so that our dogs will not slip and slide. Second, if you become aware of a problem with anything at the building, please let me know (or report it to a Board member). We can't fix problems we don't know about! Or better yet, fix the problem if you can. For example, sometimes one of our toilets will run. The fix is usually simple — either the large white flapper disc near the bottom of the tank is not seating properly, or the chain is twisted. All you have to do is remove the cover, jiggle the handle to re-seat the disc, or untwist the chain. For more serious problems that we cannot fix ourselves, I will contact our landlord.

Thanks to Cris Gill, who has recently taken over the responsibility for answering phone messages left on our club's answering machine. And thanks to Mitize Lever, who did this job previously.

I hope you all have a Happy Thanksgiving. Just keep your dogs out of the turkey!


