


Quinn earned his CGCU at Cabelas in Wheeling WV. He had to do a variety of exercises in the store. It was a fun day for him.


Cole and Firefly earned their RL1A title and Cole and his dog Mika earned 2 qualifying runs in RL1B with a fourth place in a tough level 1 group.
